Lesson 10 The Mystery of Death – Answers

1. What warning did God give Adam and Eve about death?

Of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely **die**.

2. How did Satan counter what God told Adam and Eve?

The serpent said to the woman, "You will **not** surely die.

3. How were Adam and Eve created?

The Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a **living being**.

4. If human beings don't have a soul that goes back to God at death, perhaps our "spirit" returns to God when we die?

The dust will return to the **<u>earth</u>** as it was, And the spirit will **<u>return</u>** to God who gave it.

5. Are people conscious in death?

The living know that they will die; But the dead know nothing.

6. Do dead people praise the Lord immediately after they die?

The dead do not praise the Lord, Nor any who go down into silence.

7. How did Jesus describe death?

He said to them, "Our friend Lazarus <u>sleeps</u>, but I go that I may <u>wake</u> him up."... Then Jesus said to them plainly, "Lazarus is <u>dead</u>.

8. What did Jesus say to Lazarus after Lazarus had been dead for four days?

He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!"

9. Do saved people go straight to heaven when they die?

Men and brethren, let me speak freely to you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. . . . For David did **not** ascend into the **heavens**.

10. Do people possess an immortal soul?

The soul who sins shall <u>die</u>.

11. When do the righteous dead go to heaven?

Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last **trumpet**. For the **trumpet** will sound, and the dead will be **raised** incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

12. When will the trumpet sound—signaling the resurrection of the saints?

The Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the **trumpet** of God. And the dead in Christ will **rise** first.
