

# Lesson 17 The Messiah and the Judgment – Answers

## 1. How many people will face the judgment?

We must **all** appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

## 2. Will the judgment take place prior to the Second Coming of Jesus?

Behold, I am coming quickly, and My **reward** is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.

## 3. How did the prophet Daniel describe the judgment?

I watched till thrones were put in place, And the Ancient of Days was seated . . . The **court** was seated, And the **books** were opened.

## 4. What is the purpose of the judgment?

The saints of the Most High shall receive the **kingdom**, and possess the kingdom forever, even forever and ever.

## 5. On what basis will people be judged?

God will bring every **work** into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.

Whoever shall keep the whole **law**, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all. 11 For He who said, “Do not commit adultery,” also said, “Do not murder.” Now if you do not commit adultery, but you do murder, you have become a transgressor of the law. 12 So speak and so do as those who will be judged by the **law** of liberty.

## 6. When does the judgment begin?

For two thousand three hundred days; then the sanctuary shall be **cleansed**.

## 7. What incredible prophecy reveals Jesus as the Messiah?

**Seventy** weeks are determined For your people and for your holy city, To finish the transgression, To make an end of sins, To make reconciliation for iniquity, To bring in everlasting righteousness, To seal up vision and prophecy, And to anoint the Most Holy.

## 8. In prophetic symbolism, what does a day represent?

I have laid on you a day for each **year**.

## 9. What was the starting point for this time period for the Jews?

Know therefore and understand, That from the going forth of the **command** To restore and build Jerusalem Until Messiah the Prince, There shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; The street shall be built again, and the wall, Even in troublesome times.

**10. What would happen at the end of the first 69 weeks?**

. . . until **Messiah** the Prince.

**11. What was predicted to happen to the Messiah?**

After the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be **cut off**, but not for Himself

**12. What would happen in the middle of the last week of this prophecy?**

In the middle of the week He shall bring an end to **sacrifice** and offering.

**13. To whom did Jesus tell His disciples to first preach?**

Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of **Israel**.

**14. What warning did Jesus give to the people of Israel?**

The kingdom of God will be **taken** from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it.

**15. When did the gospel really begin to go to the Gentiles?**

Devout men carried Stephen to his burial . . . Therefore those who were scattered went **everywhere** preaching the word.

**16. When was the earthly sanctuary “cleansed”?**

The tenth day of this seventh month shall be the Day of **Atonement**. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the Lord.

On that day the priest shall make atonement for you, to **cleanse** you, that you may be clean from all your sins before the Lord.

**17. How will the heavenly sanctuary be cleansed?**

It was necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens [the earthly sanctuary] should be **purified** with these, but the heavenly things themselves [the heavenly sanctuary] with **better** sacrifices than these.

**18. When will the sanctuary be cleansed?**

For two thousand three hundred days; then the sanctuary shall be **cleansed**.

**19. What impact should the judgment have on a person’s life?**

Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment **has** come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.
